



Introduction

Prior to the safety cover, the role of a winter pool cover was primarily to keep debris and dirt from entering the pool. Today, safety covers have been designed to fulfill additional objectives and benefits. They include:

- prohibit entry by human, pet or wildlife
- prevent incidental mishap and injury
- keep debris from entering the pool
- protection from the winter elements
- helps to maintain clean pool water

Water-bag Cover


A water bag cover is essentially a tarp which is kept in place by water bags (and/or blocks and other weighted objects).

In the context of safety, a tarp not only fails to keep human, pet or wildlife from incidental or accidental entry, it actually creates a false sense of stability to an unaware intruder (human, pet or wildlife) as they may construe the tarp as being a weight-bearing surface. Furthermore, a tarp can entrap and hide an accidental entry.

Pros: water-bag cover

• cheap

Cons: water-bag cover

- hassle to fill and empty water bags
- trouble moving weighted objects
- bags can puncture and leak
- not a barrier to intrusion
- can entrap human, pet or wildlife
- collects strewn trash and debris
- cumbersome to install and remove
- unbecoming and disheveled appearance
- short lifespan (prone to holes, rips, etc.)

Safety Cover

A safety cover provides so many more benefits than a tarp beginning with the essential prevention of incidental or accidental entry by human, pet or wildlife. As listed below, a properly installed safety cover serves many purposes in addition to safety.

Pros: safety cover

- prohibits entry by either human, pet or wildlife
- prevents incidental and accidental injury
- keeps debris from entering the pool
- protection from the winter elements
- helps to maintain clean pool water
- easy to install and remove as well as store
- visually pleasing (and available in multiple colors)
- 15 to 20 year life span (amortized cost is nominal)



Coverion's Superior Traits

Double Webbing and Triple Stitching

Engineered and manufactured to support 4,000 lbs per square inch, Coverlon's double webbing and triple stitching technology provide super strength infrastructure:

- black straps which criss-cross the cover are stitched on the top and the underside of the cover
- tensile strength of the double webbing and triple stitching is approximately 4,000 lbs per square inch
- double webbing for the entire cover is sewn on with triple stitched bonded threads



Heavy-Duty Springs

Forged of thick gauge steel, Coverlon's springs are engineered to handle the immense stress caused by the weight and pulling of the cover:

- the USA made heavy-duty stainless steel springs will not bend, elongate or deform
- contour of springs eliminates gaps and points of entry for debris between the cover and decking
- plastic sleeves are provided for each spring to protect the pool deck and the spring from abrasion

Anchors and End Caps

The anchors keep the safety cover locked down to the pool decking, and the end caps keep the buckles and straps from defraying:

- forged of non-corrosive brass, the anchors consist of a 2-part assembly of male and female parts NOTE: matching brass collars are optional and available at an additional cost
- drilled and installed flush to the pool decking, the threaded mechanism is easily adjusted for use
- anodized black brass end caps are machine crimped and prevent the webbing from unraveling

Your Coverlon Saftey cover comes with all of the accessories and tools you need for an easy installation, quick adjustment and simple maintenance:

- heavy-duty installation tool, tamping tool, spring covers and allen-key
- durable storage bag with a draw string is included with every cover

Our package includes a 1 year warranty for the installation: we will repair any condition(s) relevant to the installation. For example: ill-fitting cover, loose anchors, etc. In addition, we will be the steward for Coverlon's 12 year limited warranty.

Coverlon offers a 12 year limited warranty to the original purchaser. A copy of the warranty is enclosed with each cover. The highlights include:

- will repair or replace any part of new cover that has a manufacturing defect, for a period of 1 year from the date of purchase, free of cost
- warranted to be free from manufacturing defects in workmanship under normal usage, assuming proper installation and maintenance
- after the first year, any workmanship performed (repairs or replacement) will be charged a pro-rate cost of current retail prices
